A Resolution in support of the Gustavus Disposal and Recycling Center's (DRC) Recycling Equipment Grant Application to the Denali Commission's Solid Waste Program FY 2006 RFP#2 Recycling Equipment - Materials Sorting, Storage & Backhaul Grant Program

WHEREAS, the Gustavus DRC is a department of the City of Gustavus, providing for all residents and businesses of the community the opportunity for sanitary waste disposal and maximized recycling, and;

WHEREAS, the Gustavus DRC has an active recycling program, collecting, processing and shipping out such items as aluminum beverage cans, tin cans, scrap steel, consumer PETE & HDPE plastics and lead-acid batteries, and;

WHEREAS, the Gustavus DRC is seeking to purchase holding totes, sorting tubs, public collection containers and recycling equipment to facilitate the processing and shipping of a greater amount and variety of materials for the benefit of the community, and;

WHEREAS, with the recycling equipment listed in this grant application the Gustavus DRC will be better served in it's goals of diverting waste from the landfill, conserving landfill space, protecting groundwater resources, and serving as a model for other rural Alaskan communities;

AND NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Gustavus City Council endorses the Gustavus DRC's Recycling Equipment grant application to the Denali Commission's Solid Waste Program FY 2006 RFP#2 Recycling Equipment - Materials Sorting, Storage & Backhaul grant program.


