
**WHEREAS**, such hiking opportunities benefit the mental health of residents,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Gustavus has already offered financial assistance for planning and design of the proposed trails,



PASSED and APPROVED by the Gustavus City Council this 11<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2008.


