CITY OF GUSTAVUS RESOLUTION 2008-31

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE PROPOSAL TO REQUEST FUNDING FOR ENGINEERING OF THE CITY OWNED MARINE FUEL DISPENSING

WHEREAS, the City of Gustavus has no marine fueling facility at present; and

WHEREAS, residents and visitors of Gustavus have no access to marine fueling at Bartlett Cove within Glacier Bay National Park unless a limited permit is available; and

WHEREAS, the Alaska Energy Authority with funding from the Denali Commission will be building a Bulk Fuel Storage facility in Gustavus with construction scheduled to begin in the spring of 2009; and

WHEREAS, the new Bulk Fuel Storage facility has been designed to provide fuel to a future City owned marine fuel dispensing facility; and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska is planning construction of a new freight/ferry dock at Gustavus with construction tentatively starting in 2009; and

WHEREAS, the AEA Bulk Fuel Storage project budget includes funding for the pipeline to be run on the new dock with provisions for a marine fuel dispensing station; and

WHEREAS, planning and engineering of the future City owned marine fuel dispensing facility will be required to identify the location and construction methods needed to build the facility so coordination and planning with the new dock and new bulk fuel storage facility can occur; and

WHEREAS, A completed engineering plan will be required for procurement of funding, so construction can occur to coincide with construction of the new dock and bulk fuel storage facility;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the City of Gustavus supports this application for funding for engineering of the City owned marine fuel dispensing facility.
