WHEREAS, providing the community with advanced skills enhancing public and property safety,


WHEREAS, The Glacier Bay National Park has secured, through the company, Fire Management Systems (FMS), to instruct the FF I class, and


WHEREAS, The cost of the FF I class is \$75/hr for 88 hours which comes to \$6600.00 for instructor fees,




