**A Resolution Approving the Submission of a Capital Improvement Funding
Request for Planning for a new Model of Waste Handling in Gustavus**

WHEREAS, the City of Gustavus Disposal and Recycling Center serves Gustavus as a model Integrated Resource Recovery and Waste Disposal Facility, and

WHEREAS, the existing permitted landfill space will be filled within fifteen years, and

WHEREAS, the City of Gustavus is planning for the long term efficient and environmentally responsible handling of its waste stream, and


WHEREAS, the City of Gustavus anticipates participating in the South East Alaska Solid Waste Authority, and

WHEREAS, The City of Gustavus must plan now for the eventual conversion to a new model comprising recycling, composting, and waste transfer station, and

WHEREAS, The City of Gustavus seeks to use a professional consultant to create a model facility that will serve long into the future.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Gustavus City Council approves the CIP funding request to the 2012 Alaska Legislature in the amount of \$30,000 for planning for a new model of waste handling in Gustavus, and urges the Legislature and Governor to consider it favorably.
