RESOLUTION 2012-06**

**A Resolution Approving the Submission of a Capital Improvement Funding
Request for GVFD Station 1 Expansion Project**

WHEREAS, the Gustavus Volunteer Fire Department has in the last 14 months been reorganized under the direction of a new professional fire chief, and

WHEREAS, the Department volunteer roster has grown with volunteers who are building new emergency response skills and certifications, and

WHEREAS, the GVFD Fire Station 1 has been remodeled within its existing footprint to optimize space for fire and EMS apparatus storage and for volunteer training, and


WHEREAS, the Department has recently acquired a replacement tanker and a second pumper truck, through excess equipment sales, and

WHEREAS, two key pieces of fire apparatus are currently stored off site due to limited space in Fire Station 1, and


WHEREAS, GVFD plans to expand Station 1 adding four apparatus bays with drive-through access at the back of the station to house trucks where they can be properly maintained and be immediately accessible for emergency response.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Gustavus City Council approves the CIP funding request to the 2012 Alaska Legislature in the amount of \$150,000 for the Expansion of Fire Station 1 adding two new apparatus bays, and urges the Legislature and Governor to consider it favorably.




