**A RESOLUTION TO ENCOURAGE EFFORTS TOWARDS THE CREATION OF AN
ASSISTED LIVING FACILITY IN GUSTAVUS**

WHEREAS, there is currently no service in Gustavus that keeps our elders and neighbors in our community when their home life is no longer sustainable; and,

WHEREAS, the need for these types of services is growing reflecting a trend across the country, a result of an aging “ baby boomer” population and the growing expense of care in a traditional nursing home not covered by Medicare; and,


