RESOLUTION 2014-13**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING CITY OF GUSTAVUS NON-FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR FISH  
PASSAGE IMPROVEMENTS AT TWO NON-CITY-OWNED SITES**

**WHEREAS**, the Gustavus Fish Passage Improvement Project seeks to improve traffic safety and eliminate fish passage barriers at five culverted road crossings along the stream paralleling Mountain View Road and Good River Road, and

**WHEREAS**, the project is funded by grants from the US Fish and Wildlife Service, the State of Alaska, and other granting agencies, and

**WHEREAS**, two of the sites where fish passage is seriously restricted along the stream are private driveways from the west side of Mountain View Road. One enters the property of Block B, Lot 7 of the 1979 State Subdivision Plat 79-179. The other enters an unplatted subdivision lot of a former homestead and is located approximately 530 feet south-southwest of the intersection of Mountain View Road with Tong Road.

**WHEREAS**, the project design work and planned construction is being managed by a volunteer project manager assigned by the Mayor, and


**WHEREAS**, the City is the project manager for the three City-owned sites, and


**WHEREAS**, consistency in project management and bidding standards across all five sites will enhance project completion,

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Gustavus City Council approves City ownership of the project construction at the two private driveway sites being managed by the volunteer project manager. The Council approves pass-through grant funding for construction, and in-kind bidding and payment services via the office of the City Clerk for the two private driveways. The City does not take ownership of, or maintenance responsibility for, the constructed facilities once complete. No city funds are approved for work at the private driveway sites.
