The City of Gustavus Disposal and Recycling Center will be filled within five years. The City anticipates participating in the S.E. Alaska Solid Waste Authority. The City must plan for the eventual conversion of a new model of waste disposal consisting of trans-shipping non-recyclable waste to a regional facility. The desire is to hire a professional consultant to draft a solid waste plan that describes a state-of-the-art waste handling facility, utilizing best business practices and high environmental standards which will serve the community for 50+ years.

Anticipate developing RFP by July 1, 2013. Hiring of design firm would commence 30-60 days later.

**A Resolution Approving the Submission of a Capital Improvement Project
Funding Request for the Development of a Comprehensive Solid Waste
Management and Facility Plan for the City of Gustavus**

WHEREAS, The City of Gustavus Disposal and Recycling Center (DRC) serves Gustavus as a model Integrated Resource Recovery and Waste Disposal Facility, and;

WHEREAS, the existing permitted landfill space at the DRC will be filled within five years, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Gustavus is planning for the long term efficient and environmentally responsible processing of its waste stream, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Gustavus anticipates participating in the South East Alaska Solid Waste Authority or other potential regional waste processing entities, and

WHEREAS, The City of Gustavus must plan now for the eventual conversion to a new model of waste disposal consisting of transshipping non-recyclable waste to a regional facility rather than landfilling within the existing facility, and;


WHEREAS, The City of Gustavus seeks to use professional consultant(s) to draft a Solid Waste Management and Facility Plan that describes a state of the art waste handling facility, utilizing best business practices and high environmental standards which will serve the community for more than 50 years.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Gustavus City Council approves the FY 14 CIP funding request to the Alaska Legislature in the amount of \$70,000 for the Development of a Comprehensive Solid Waste Management and Facility Plan for the City of Gustavus, and urges the Legislature and Governor to consider it favorably.
